

March 7th: March and Rally in Los Angeles and Candle-light Vigil in Orange County

Demonstrating against a law that has given approximately 2,500 Californians 25 years-to-life for nonviolent and non-serious offenses over the last five years, about 150 people marched through the streets of Los Angeles to a rally and about 100 people attended a candle-light vigil in Orange County. Dennis Duncan, President of the Los Angeles Chapter, introduced many speakers at the Los Angeles Rally, and there were many speakers at the Orange County Candle-Light Vigil, including Judge Jim Gray of Orange County.



At exactly 2:45 p.m. the crowd at the rally had a moment of silence to reflect on the exact time when the 3-strikes law became effective 5 years prior and the subsequent horrible results. There were tears in many people's eyes. Reporters were present from CBS News, ABC News, KCAL9, the Los Angeles Times, National Public Radio and KPFK at the March and Rally in Los Angeles, and OCN, Channel 13, and the Orange County Register at the Candle light vigil in Orange County.
